## **HISTORY OF THE INSTITUTION**

This institution started functioning as Govt. Primary School at Village Jhagriani in a private building in 1925-26. Later it was shifted to Village Dhaned, but its name remained Jhagriani. In 1956 it was upgraded as Middle School, under the Control of Distt. Board Kangra. In 1969 it was upgraded as High School and then Sr. Secondary School in 1995 under 10+2 system of education. It is situated at a distance of 18 km from Hamirpur on Hamirpur-Salauni road via Bari Pharnohal. The school campus is spread over an area of 20.5 Kanals in Dhaned locality.

## **THE SCHOOL CAMPUS**

This institution has spacious building with beautiful green campus. The school building comprises of 28 rooms including the library and Laboratories which seems to be sufficient according to the strength of students. As new examination hall has been constructed to cater to the needs of students. All the rooms are airy and well-furnished. At present about 342 students are studying in this institution. There are about 28 teachers and 6 other non-teaching employees in the staff. There are 15 toilets and a bathroom. A beautiful art & craft room has been constructed and maths and language.

For sports activities, a badminton ground, Basket ball ground, Volley-ball, Kho-kho ground, Kabaddi Synthetic Court, Table Tennis, Boxing games, Digital Library & Digital Classroom are available in the campus. Well furnished stairs have been constructed near the ground to watch the matches with grace. We have six smart classrooms with internet connectivity.

# ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE

There will be three admission committees one for Humanities Group, Second for Commerce Group and third for Science Group. The students are advised to get the brochure on payment in which the admission form is attached. Fill in the admission form carefully after having gone through the contents of the Brochure. Admission form duly filled in to be produced before the admission committee.

Admission to each course will be subject to fulfilment of minimum eligibility conditions.

## HUMANITIES GROUP

- (i) To get admission in +1 application should have passed Matriculation or equivalent Examination with 33% marks from any Board/ School recognized by H.P. Board of School Education.
- (ii) He/She Should have passed Matriculation exam or equivalent exam with English Subject.

## SCIENCE GROUP/ COMMERCE GROUP

To seek admission in Science faculty an application should have obtained at least 50% marks & in Commerce Faculty should obtained 40% marks in Matriculation or equivalent exam.

Note : No student will be allowed to seek admission if :

- i. He/She has failed two times in the same class.
- ii. He/She attained the age of 20 years.
- iii. Changes subject after 31st May.
- iv. Changes faculty after 10 days of admission.
- v. In case of gap of one year or more in studies, the student will have to produce affidavit by executive magistrate as a proof.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. The application must carefully read all rules, eligibility conditions and instructions before filling up the admission form.
2. The admission form is to be filled up neatly by the applicant in his/her own handwriting.
3. The applicant has to bring his/her mother/father/guardians with him/her while getting admission in the school.  
(No student of this school sign in the place of father/mother/ guardian of any applicant).
4. The applicant should paste with gum a passport size photograph in the admission form.
5. The form complete in all respects along with original school leaving certificate/character certificate from the head of the institution last attended is to be produced before the admission committee.

**Note :** Internet result will not be entertained.

In case any clarification or help is required the applicant can approach any teacher of the school or non-teaching staff of school.

**N.B.**

1. All terms and conditions can be changed on instructions from Secretary B.O.S.E. Dharamshala or Education Department.
2. The Principal reserve the right to reject or cancel the admission of any applicant without assigning any reason if a student gets admission on the basis of wrong information or by concealing certain facts.
3. After getting the forms approved and verified from the admission committee the applicant will have to get the principal and finally the applicant will deposit the admission form and admission dues on the same day with the office clerk.
4. H.P. Domicil certificate and category certificate are to be submitted only by those who want/seek any sort of fee concession or scholarship under S.C./S.T./IRDP Schemes of States/Centre Govt.
5. All the students who have appeared in Matriculation or equivalent Exam can seek admission in +1 provisionally before 20th of April, but will have to seek regular admission within 10 days of the declaration of the result without late fee and date of admission with late fee will be displayed on the notice board later on.



## MORNING ASSEMBLY

The school start functioning with the morning assembly in which all the students take part will all the Teachers/Lecturers to grace the morning assembly. It start with National song and ends with National Anthem. Necessary steps are taken to make the morning assembly more effective and interesting. In order to maintain discipline in the school all the students have been divided in to four houses.

Each house has been entrusted the responsibility to make the morning assembly more interesting and effective for a week. During this period, Teachers also delive rspeechles to promote moral values and all round development of the students. In addition to it the principal of the school also apprise the students about the values of various festivals on carious occasion such as Independence Day, Republic day, Teacher's Day, Children Day and other festivals, we look after the educational excursions. Important instructions are given to the students in the morning assembly.

## CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Cultural program is held in the 8th and 9th period on every Saturday of the week.

The students are encouraged to participate in various co-curricular and extra curricular activities like seminar recitation, contests, paper reading and educational excursions.

The school has a playground and the most proficient physical instructors who have produced a number of players especially in Kho-Kho, Badminton, Volley Ball and Athletic and Basketball, Kabaddi, Table Tennis, Boxing etc.

## EXAMINATION

There will be two term examination in a year. First in the month of October and the second in the month of March. The progress report is regularly sent to the parents/guardians of the students. Despite these term exam., monthly, tests are also conducted and the students who are placed in distinction (more than 75%marks) will be honored with handsome prize at the time of Prize Distribution Function which is held once in year. Pre-board examination has been started in the institution to gear up students for best performance.

## **UNIFORM AT THE CAMPUS**

In order to maintain uniformity irrespective of rich and poor, caste, creed and colour. There will a uniform prescribed by the school authorities while they are in the school, no students will be allowed to entre the school without prescribed uniform which is as under.
